COVID TESTING RESULTS & TRAVEL GUIDANCE

We are grateful for the good health of our community, and that so many of our students are now fully vaccinated. All the test results from staff and student testing last Friday and this Tuesday were negative, except for one which was inconclusive. It was then retested with a negative result.

Alameda County and Bay Area COVID case rates and hospitalization rates remain fairly low, though they are increasing slightly. **We are continuing to practice the prevention measures that have kept our students and staff safe**, given the holidays and the Omicron variant, and ask all families to take precautions when gathering indoors.

Some community members have asked about our policy regarding travel over Winter Break. We ask all families to follow the <u>state travel guidance</u> that recommends that only fully-vaccinated individuals travel outside the area. Please see the State's <u>Holiday Gathering Fact Sheet</u> for further guidance. Any family that is choosing to travel internationally over the break should follow the latest Restrictions for <u>International Travel</u>, requiring travelers to test for COVID-19 within 1 day of their departure and recommending that unvaccinated individuals self-quarantine for seven (7) days after returning from a foreign country.

We will again be requiring all families to upload a negative COVID test


