

Strategic planning provides an important opportunity to think collectively about what we all hope for the future of our school, students, and community.

• **Process Overview** — With support of our strategic planning facilitators from Living Strategy, we will collaboratively work with our community to create the plan this year in 5 phases this year.

• **Recent Progress** — We recently completed our Phase 1 planning and preparation to create a calendar of activities for the year. We are now moving into Phase 2, when we will collect community input and form a Strategic Planning Task Force to help guide and inform the process and shape recommendations for the Board to consider in Spring / Summer.

• **Community Input** — Over the next two months, we will collect community input and have two different opportunities for you to contribute your ideas and help brainstorm themes to consider. These opportunities will include an online survey and live focus groups next month. We hope you will be able to join us to participate in both. To get us started, we are reaching out to ask that you please take 10-15 minutes today to complete this quick Strategic Planning Survey before: Monday, Nov. 23.

• Take the survey \rightarrow The <u>survey</u> is intentionally open-ended at this early stage because we want to hear from you about what themes and areas of focus you think our soon-to-be-formed Task Force should focus on as they begin to research ideas and draft recommendations for the Board to consider by year-end.
