Dear Park Day Families,

What a historic week this has been with the administration of the first Covid-19 vaccines in California. This has been a long time coming and a definite reason to celebrate. What is tough is that this good news is happening concurrently with an almost exponential increase in new cases in our region. So the quote that Governor Newsom used earlier this week in his press conference was spot on, "There is light at the end of the tunnel, but we are still in the tunnel."

With that reality, and to protect our faculty, staff, and students during this time, we are building in a full two weeks of distance learning after the winter break instead of the one week that was originally planned. This means that we plan to return to on-campus learning on Tuesday, January 19, with all students and staff being tested on Wednesday, January 13, at Park Day. This, like so many things we are dealing with this year, is subject to shift should the County or State guidance change.

In addition to the on-site student testing date on January 13, all other members of your household are strongly encouraged to take a COVID-19 test via **Curative** or another service before students return to campus. Curative testing will be offered weekly on Sundays in the 44th street parking lot.


