A Message From Park Day's AAPI Family Affinity Group

This past Saturday, following the amazing PDS Getaway, a Park Day AAPI Affinity Group gathered - 50+ strong - in Oakland's Chinatown to stroll, discover, and show our support for one of the oldest Chinatowns in the US (dating to the 1850s!).

Our group represented 5 different LS and MS grades and also included 5 new families who will be starting Park Day in the fall. We split into 3 different groups and participated in a guided tour and a scavenger hunt before ending with dinner and cross-age play in Chinatown's Lincoln Park.

Our guide - Roy Chan, a former Oakland Asian Cultural Center staff who's conducted an extensive oral history project to preserve & share stories from residents - packed each 30 min tour with rich stories about the history of the neighborhood's building and people. For the first time, many of us learned about the earliest person to pilot a plane on the west coast (1909), Oakland resident Feng Yu.

It's not uncommon for our AAPI students at Park Day (and staff!) to feel as if they are the "only ones." But this weekend, just as our 2nd grader Kenzi appreciated during our closing: "...before I didn't know how many Asian families there were at Park Day" and this is just the beginning. Our response to these challenging times is to build unity across ages, connect over shared love of hand cut noodles at Shandong and dan ta, and use our sheer presence to bring comfort.
