COVID TESTING RESULTS & TRAVEL GUIDANCE

We are again happy to announce that all COVID tests from last Friday and this past Tuesday were negative. COVID case rates and hospitalization rates in Alameda County are increasing slightly, but still low in comparison to the rest of the US. Vaccination rates are also increasing with over 78% of the total County population (including children) vaccinated, and over a quarter of those under 12 fully vaccinated (good news!!). Boosters are now available for everyone 16 and over, and strongly encouraged. We are hopeful that all of our students will be fully vaccinated by early 2022.

The effects of the Omicron mutation are just starting to show up, and so vigilance is important as we head into the next few weeks. Health officials and experts are still learning more about Omicron, but at this point expecting it to spread widely. Booster shots have been shown to help in the prevention of severe disease with Omicron. Our other tools also help, including masking and testing. Make sure to test before and after travel and holiday gatherings per the **State Travel** and **Holiday Gathering** Guidance, and stay home if you are sick.

As previously mentioned, all staff and students need to upload a negative COVID test result taken between Dec 31 and January 3 before returning to campus on January 3 or 4th. Reminders will be sent out through Titan at the end of the break. If you have more than one student, please take a photo of the results of all students and upload that. We thank you for helping to keep our community safe and healthy.
